

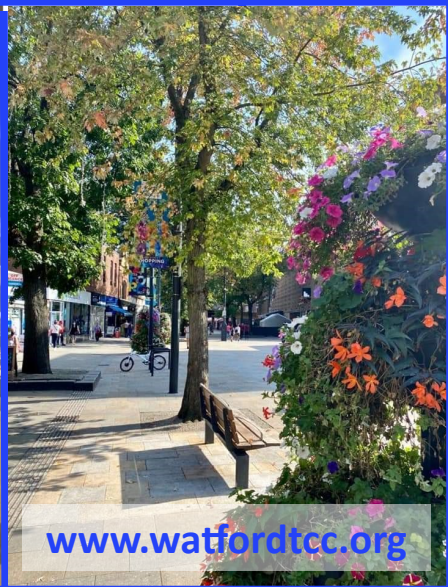

## About the Chaplaincy

The Chaplaincy, which began in 2004, currently has volunteer **Chaplains** in shops, businesses and other work-places in the town centre:

⇒ **Chaplains** are friendly and familiar faces, ready to listen to staff who need to get something off their chest while at work, or have a deeper conversation about anything that's troubling them, including addiction, bereavement, family, loneliness, pets, suicide, and trust, among many other topics. They are independent of the organisations they visit, adding value by attending to people's emotional and spiritual well-being, which reduces absenteeism and workplace stress, and improves staff satisfaction, retention, and productivity.

We also have teams of volunteer **Street Angels** which support the night time economy at weekends and on other 'special' nights:

⇒ our **Street Angels** walk around between 10.00pm and 3.00am looking for those leaving the pubs, clubs and restaurants who might be in need of a helping hand or a listening ear. They can also offer items of need (bottles of water, 'slippers', sick bags, wipes, rain ponchos, foil blankets etc).

All our volunteers receive training, induction, and ongoing supervision and wear a distinctive uniform. They only discuss their Christian faith if they are asked to.

The Chaplaincy employs a full-time **Lead Chaplain** and a part-time **Administrator** both of whom work out of a Chaplaincy Room based in St Mary's Church in the centre of Watford.

We have support from a diverse range of churches in Watford and the surrounding areas through prayer and finance. We work in partnership with a wide range of other agencies, including Watford BID, Watford Council and Watford Chamber of Commerce.

Chaplaincy services are free of charge to anyone and everyone; we work with and alongside people of all faiths and none.
